At VITAC, our audio description scriptwriters carefully analyze each video to determine what visual content to describe. Scriptwriters craft concise descriptions to maintain the flow of the video and the cadence of the original audio track. VITAC follows the Audio Description Coalition's standards and the Described and Captioned Media Program's "Description Key" to provide consistent, high-quality audio descriptions.

VITAC scriptwriters are educated professionals with backgrounds in writing and journalism or graduates of the well-respected American Council of the Blind's Audio Description Institute.



All of VITAC's scriptwriters have either significant experience in the field or undergo tests and training to develop their ability to craft quality audio descriptions.




VITAC scriptwriters use state-of-the-art software that allows them to pause, edit, rewind, and process the video's words to create precise audio description.

Users upload their videos via our web portal or through our 30+ integrations. VITAC's professional scriptwriters craft the descriptions.

The scriptwriters send the completed audio description file back to Verbit.

Verbit generates the audio description output in the user's preferred format.
